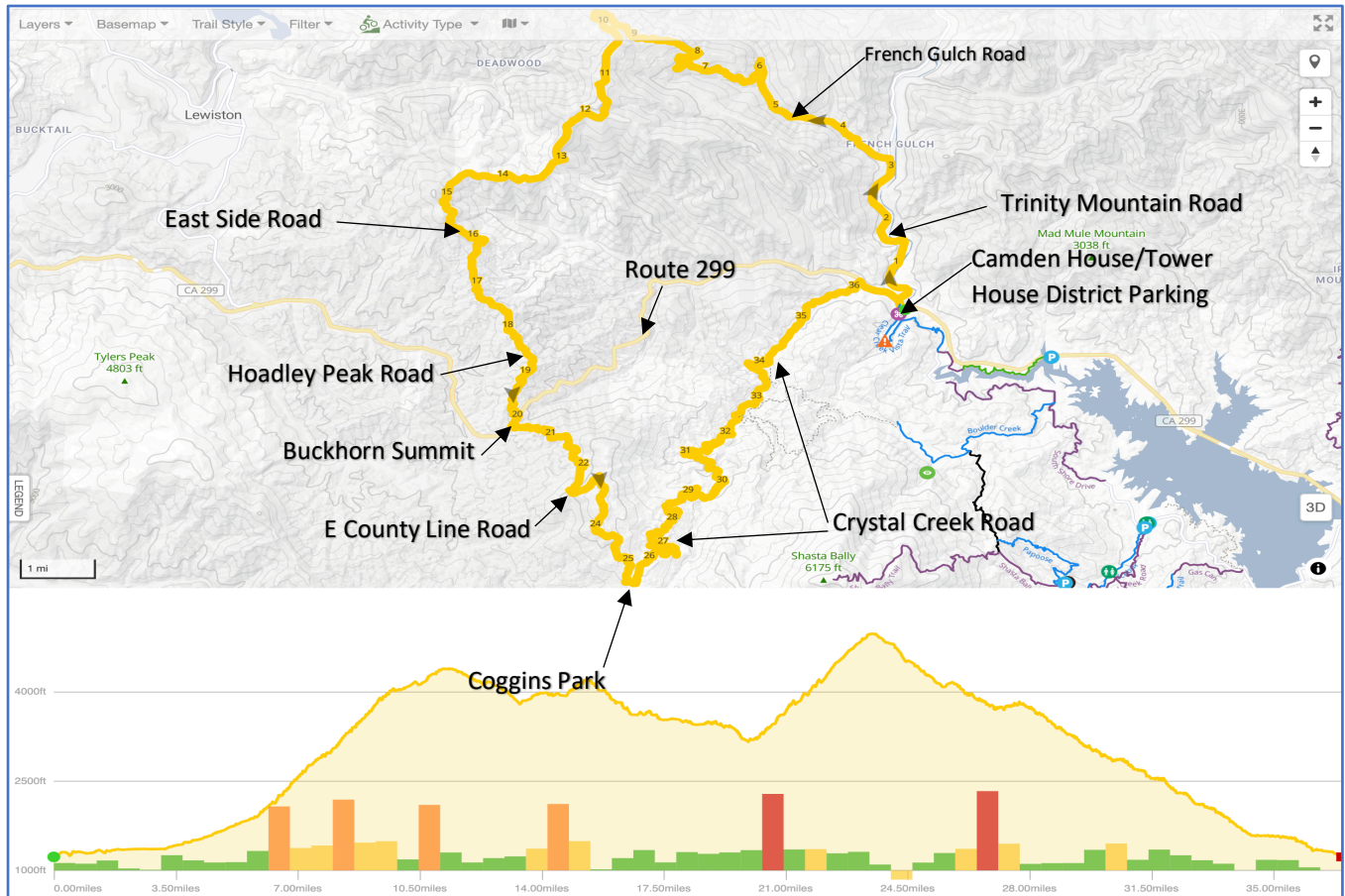




Bigfoot Adventure Challenge

AK's Buckhorn Adventure Route



Distance and Elevation: 37 miles and 5800 feet of climbing

Trailhead Location: Tower House District Parking Lot – Whiskeytown NRA

Route Directions:

1. Camden House to French Gulch Road – cross 299 to Trinity Mountain Road and north to French Gulch Road.
2. French Gulch Road to East Side Road (some might call it County Line Road) – big climb, number of private road intersections, stay on the main road to the ridge top County line.
3. East Side Road to Buckhorn – Take the up and down East Side Road which turns into Hoadley Peak Road when it crosses the Lewiston Turnpike Road to Route 299 and Buckhorn Summit.
4. E County Line Road to Coggins Park – another big climb and decent to Coggins Park and unpaved portion of Crystal Creek Road
5. Crystal Creek Road to Start – down the unpaved, rugged in spots Crystal Creek Road to the paved portions and a fast decent all the way to Route 299, right on 299 and a very short distance to your Camden House/Tower District start.

Summary: This Bigfoot Adventure Challenge on the very west edge of Shasta County is truly and adventure ride. The rider can expect a couple long challenging climbs on low to no travel gravel and dirt roads along with fun descents with amazing views back into Shasta County and into Trinity County
