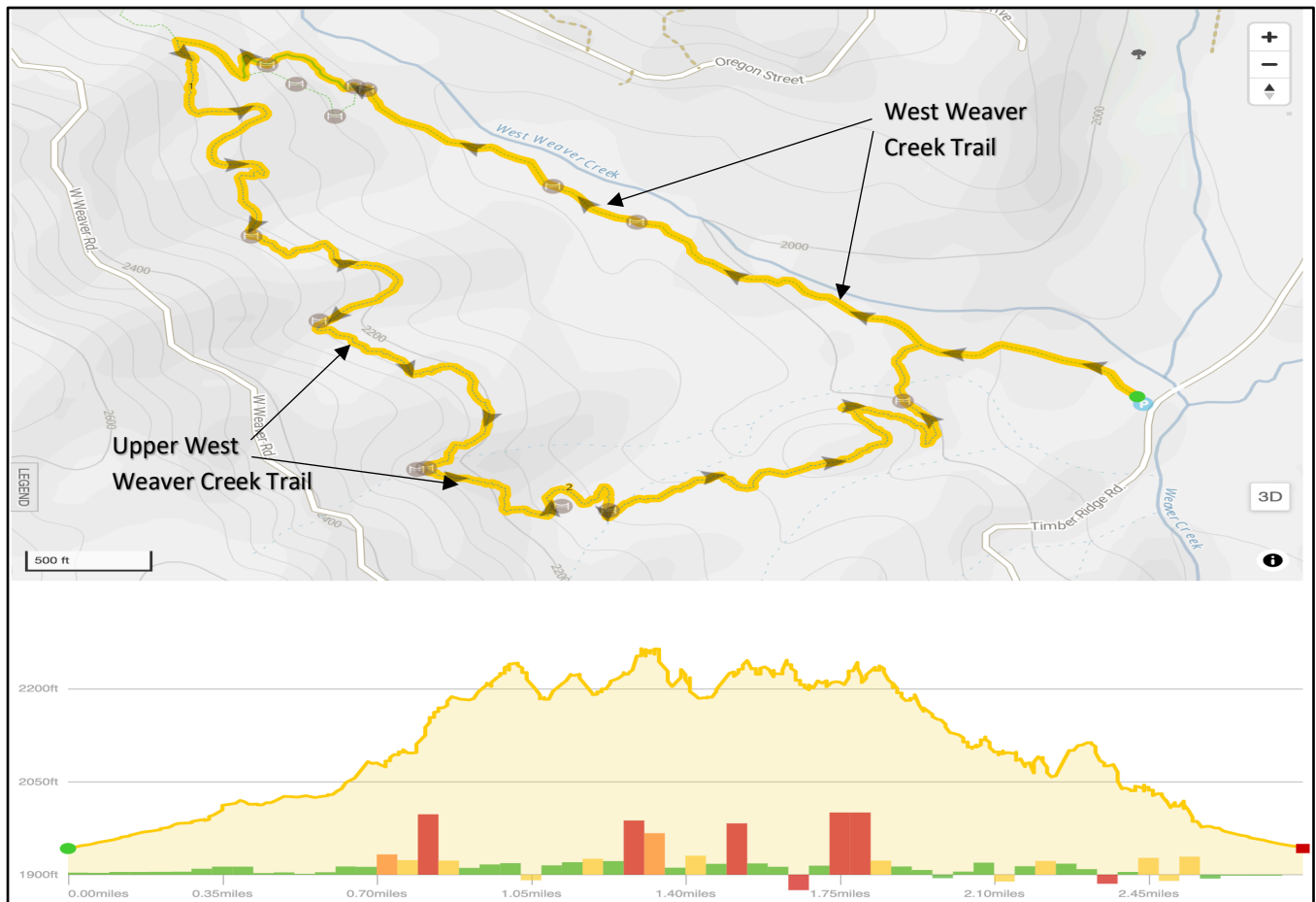




Bigfoot Adventure Challenge

West Weaver Creek Trail Route Information



Distance and Elevation: 2.7 miles and 700 feet of climbing

Trailhead Location: West Weaver Creek Trailhead – Mill Street – Weaverville, CA

Route Directions:

1. West Weaver Creek Trailhead – Mill Street – just past the crossing of West Weaver Creek
2. West Weaver Creek Trail – head upstream on the West Weaver Creek Trail, enjoy the historic tailing piles and other mining features before climbing some
3. Upper West Weaver Creek Trail – left off the West Weaver Creek Trail to the Upper West Weaver Creek Trail and climb some before the trail settles in and out of some ditches with cool bridges and a few benches for a needed (?) rest.
4. West Weaver Creek Trail – descend to West Weaver Creek Trail, head right and downstream to your start.

Summary: This Bigfoot Adventure Challenge highlights an amazing and little used trail system on the southwest side of the Weaverville Basin. The Trail user can expect to experience traversing through historic tailing piles, climbing through a gorgeous oak woodland and traversing high above West Weaver Creek on the edge of old mining ditches.
